Financial Report:

Mayor's Report:

New Business

Set Date for Annual Workshop: It was the consensus of the board to set the annual workshop for February 28, 2020, to begin at 12:15 p.m. The 2020-2021 budget will be the top priority of the meeting. Lunch will be provided and the meeting should take approximately four hours.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Short Term Rentals (STR):

Mayor Rodes referenced a Coates' Canons blog discussing STR units. She would prefer the town develop a proactive ordinance rather then having to be reactionary to problems that may develop in the future. Current Webster ordinances only specifically address airbnb units in residential homes. Attorney Morgan advised that an ordinance must clearly define what a STR is and the uses allowed on the property. While adopting such an ordinance would not be difficult, implementation and enforcement must also be considered. It was the consensus of the board to review the blog and look at the ordinances of towns similar in size to Webster and continue the discussion at the next meeting or annual workshop.

2. Digitizing Records:

An estimate of \$250 was received from Jon Welch of WorkPlace Solutions for scanning old minutes in town hall. This would cover one-half day of work. It was the consensus of the board for the clerk to ask Mr. Welch to sign a contract including a confidentiality clause prior to any work being completed.

Motion: Commissioner Moses moved to digitize minutes. Commissioner Young seconded. Motion carried.
