




Q3 How do you prefer to receive news about events happening in Webster?choose up to three







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

Q5 Which term best reflects your opinion of Webster's regulations for residential development?






Q7 Should Webster's zoning regulations allow accessory dwellings (ie. apartment above a garage, mother-in-law suite)?


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Q8 Should the Town of Webster regulate short-term vacation rentals, like Airbnb or VRBO?



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

Q10 Should Webster's zoning regulations offer housing opportunities for all income levels?






Q16 Which of these best describe how you use the Tuckasegee River in Webster?check all that apply




Q21 What types of cultural opportunities should Webster be supporting? check all that apply





Q22 Would you support underground utility lines?





Q23 Do you consider your Webster taxes to be...




